Call to Order: 4:04 p.m.

Russ moved to accept the October meeting minutes.. Susan seconded. The minutes were approved.

Librarian's Report

Kris reported that she had returned to ordering books from Baker and Taylor as they offered a discount, paid shipping and sent a clear bill. She also has been culling old books and sending them to Baker and Taylor in exchange for book credits.

Jeff has helped to clear up the computer issues the library was having.

There are now two weekly van deliveries on Tuesday and Friday which means inter-library ordered books will arrive faster.

Treasurer's Report

Lew reported that the library finances continued to look good. The TD Bank Money Market Fund increased by \$1.62 for a balance of \$19,619.06. The Raymond James account increased by \$3,479.65 for a balance of \$119,578.27. There is currently \$1,820.53 in the checking account.

Susan moved to accept the Treasurer's report. Russ seconded. The report was approved.

The 2022 Proposed Budget was then discussed.

Russ moved to accept it. Gretchen seconded. All approved.

Correspondence

Russ reported there was no new correspondence.

New Business

Both Susan and Russ reported that they were not going to be candidates for Library Trustee when both their terms expire in March. There was discussion about possible other Trustee and alternate Trustee candidates.

Russ reported that he had sealed the picnic tables and removed one of the umbrellas for storage, but the other umbrella was stuck. It was agreed to meet Thursday morning at 10:00 a.m. to help unstick the umbrella.

The Library Health Protocol was discussed and no changes were made.

Susan moved to adjourn the meeting. Russ seconded. All approved. The meeting was adjourned at 5:07 p.m.
